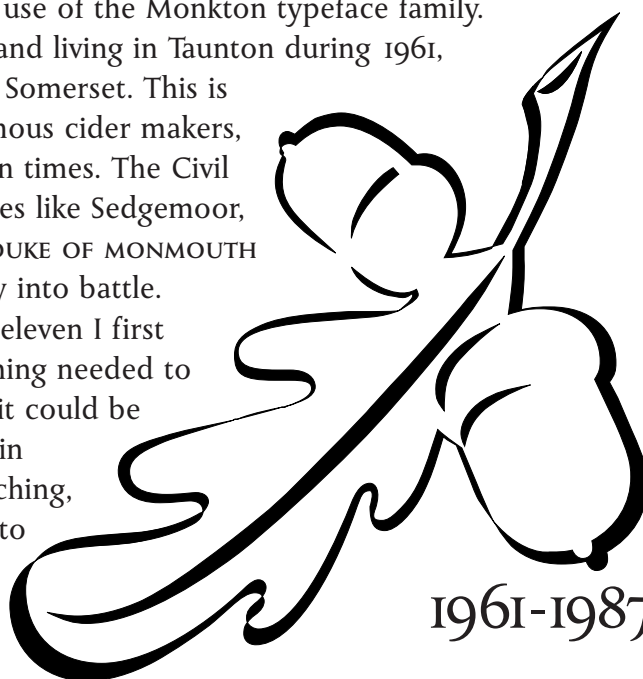

The rich and varied use of the Monkton typeface family. Born in Bridgwater and living in Taunton during 1961, the County town of Somerset. This is the home of the famous cider makers, dating back to Saxon times. The Civil War saw many battles like Sedgemoor, where, in 1685 the DUKE OF MONMOUTH led his ill fated army into battle. It was at the age of eleven I first realized that everything needed to be designed before it could be produced and, that in addition to my sketching, it was also possible to draw a very thin clean line with a technical pen.
